Congress and Event Capacity : Up to 3 000 delegates



At the crossroads of Switzerland and Italy, **Grenoble-Alpes Metropole** is situated in an ideal location **at the heart of the French Alps**. **Three** international airports are located less than 90 minutes from Grenoble (Lyon Saint-Exupéry, Geneva and Grenoble Alpes Isère). In total, more than **200 direct destinations** are accessible. With up to 10 direct Grenoble-Paris round trips by high-speed TGV train, and with the Lyon Part-Dieu hub 1h15mins away, the rail offer from Grenoble is also very attractive. **Ideally located in the city centre**, Grenoble railway station is perfectly connected to the city's bus and

tram network.

Sustainable metropolis and European green capital

A committed region, **Grenoble Alpes** is the ideal destination for event organizers concerned about the environmental impact of their events. The metropolis is implementing a proactive policy for the energy transition of its territory, and its exemplary environmental credentials have earned it the title of **European Green Capital 2022**, thanks to the collective efforts of a wide range of players.

A hub of innovation, Grenoble Alpes has been a **pioneer in sustainability**: the first French urban area to implement an Air Energy and Climate Plan, and the first to create an eco-neighborhood.

The city has an **efficient public transportation network**, with five tram lines and 80 bus routes. All convention centers and over 90% of hotels are accessible by tram, facilitating eco-friendly event planning. Grenoble Alpes is also the second-leading metropolitan area in France for cycling, with 320 km of bike lanes.

Encouraging eco-friendly initiatives in energy, housing, mobility, food, air quality, and biodiversity preservation, Grenoble Alpes Métropole serves as a model of a committed and sustainable region. Event service providers are also part of this approach and are dedicated to developing eco-responsible offerings and services.

The innovative city in the Alps

A blend of mountain spirit and urban culture, the Grenoble metropolitan area stands out from other French and European cities due to its immediate proximity to the Alpine massifs (Chartreuse, Belledonne, Vercors, Ecrins) and the economic, academic, and technological excellence of its innovation ecosystem. **Europe Capital of Innovation 2026**, Grenoble is constantly reinventing the future. Here, laboratories, universities and companies work together to make the world of tomorrow. Vibrant and open to the world, Grenoble Alpes is a premier destination for all types of professional gatherings, from conferences to corporate events.

- **The Grenoble Bastille Cable Car** is a symbol of the city and has been taking visitors to the Chartreuse Regional Natural Park since 1934. The cable car symbolizes the connection between the city and the mountains. A visit to the Fort de la Bastille is a must to admire the city and the surrounding mountains. The panoramic views from the summit are breathtaking!
- **A cultural and artistic destination**
Designated a "City of Art and History" since 2017, the city is home to the Musée de Grenoble, one of Europe's most prestigious museums, with the second-largest collection of modern art in France. Around twenty museums are located within the metropolitan area. A Street Art destination, Grenoble hosts the "Grenoble Street Art Fest," Europe's first street art festival, featuring 50 artists and over 115 painted murals.
