Easily accessible, the city is just 1.5 hours from Paris and Lyon, and 2 hours from Strasbourg, Zurich, and Lausanne. It is well connected to the airports of Bâle-Mulhouse, Strasbourg, Paris Charles de Gaulle, and Lyon Saint Exupéry. Upon arrival at the station, you are immediately in the city center, with direct access to two tram lines and a pedestrianized area where everything is within walking distance.
