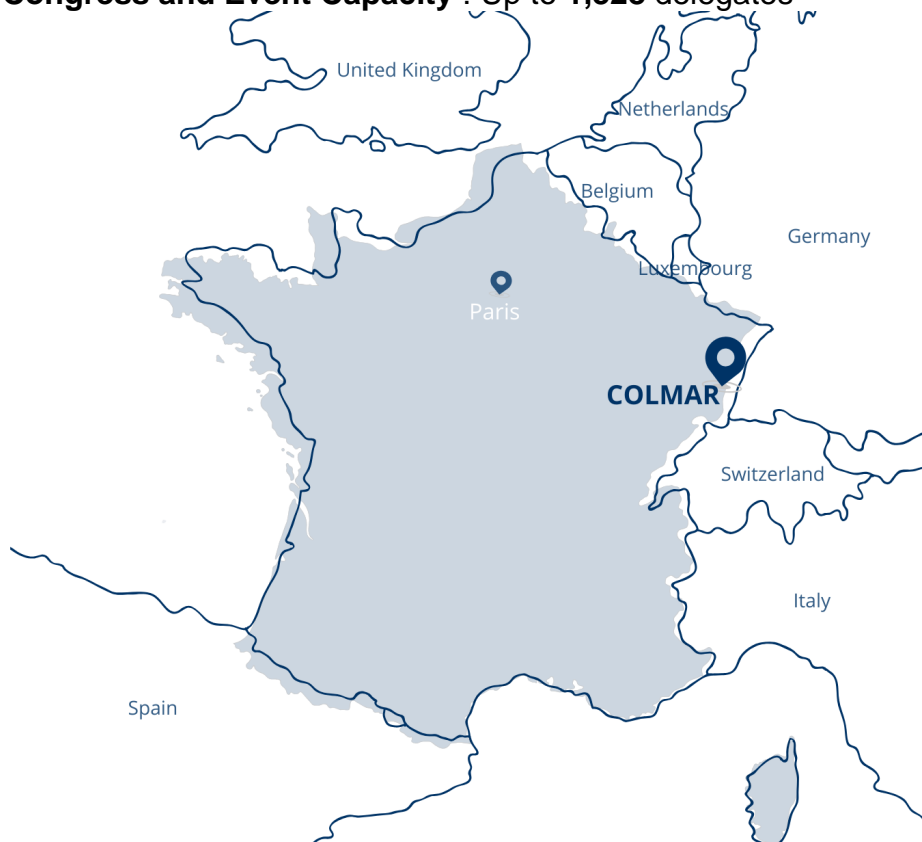

At the crossroads of major European routes, between **Strasbourg**, **Freiburg** and **Basel**, and at the gateway to **Germany** and **Switzerland**, Colmar's exceptional location makes it an ideal starting point for discovering the entire Upper Rhine region.

The excellent transport network offers fast connections **by train** (02h20 by direct TGV from Paris), **by road** and easy access to the **international airports** of Strasbourg and Basel-Mulhouse (70 km from Colmar). Colmar also has a business airport.

Commitment to sustainability

Colmar is increasingly recognized not only for its **cultural heritage** and **tourism appeal** but also for its **deep commitment to sustainability** and **responsible development**. In recent years, Colmar and many of its local partners have taken proactive steps to integrate environmental, social, and economic responsibility into how they operate, host visitors, and promote tourism.

One clear example of this commitment is the adoption of the **Green Key label** (Clef Verte) by several hotel establishments in and around Colmar's city centre. The Green Key is an international ecological certification for tourism and hospitality providers that meet strict environmental and sustainability criteria. Colmar's sustainability focus extends beyond tourism accommodation to include major community infrastructure and events. A landmark achievement in this area is the recent certification of **Colmar Expo** and the associated **Espace Auguste** under the **ISO 20121 standard**. ISO 20121 is an international management system standard developed specifically for socially responsible event planning and execution. It helps organizations identify and manage environmental, social, and economic impacts associated with events in a structured and measurable way.

Innovation and Dynamic Economy

Alsace is a center of research and innovation, home to renowned universities and high-tech companies.

INRAE is located in Colmar: inheriting a long history dedicated to viticulture, the INRAE Grand Est - Colmar center conducts research programs aimed at acquiring knowledge and developing innovations for **sustainable viticulture**.

Colmar and its surrounding region host numerous industrial companies (to name just a few: Liebherr France and Liebherr-Mining Equipment, Capsugel, Timken...) as well as competitiveness clusters across various sectors.

Diversity of venues and hotels

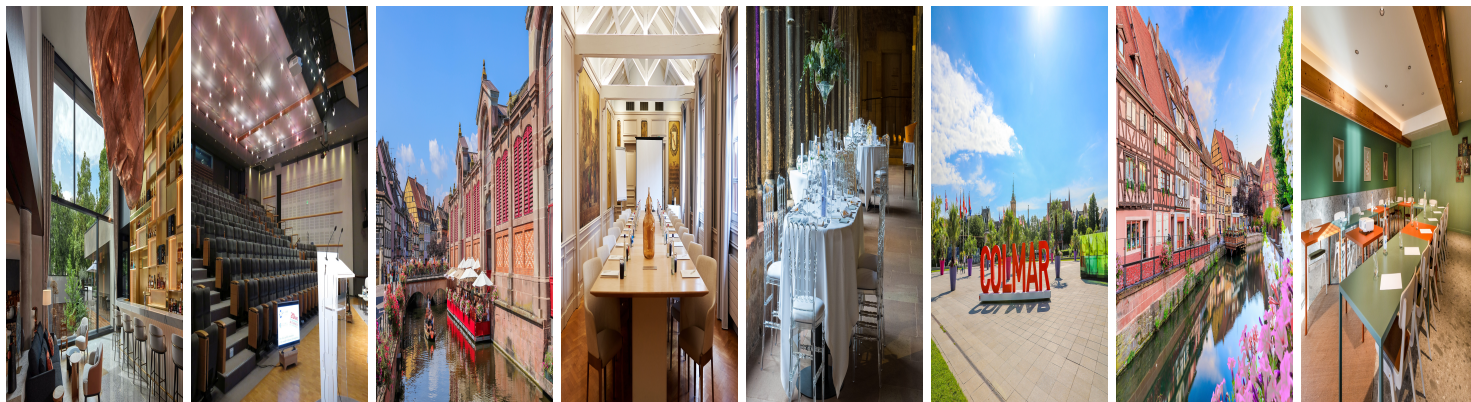
