The city offers a range of venues for all types of events, including the prestigious Palais des Congrès, several conference centers, and unique locations for memorable gatherings. The International City of Gastronomy and Wine, a true symbol of French know-how, features restaurants, shops, meeting rooms, and prestigious wine cellars, making Dijon a one-of-a-kind destination for events.
