

COUR DES LOGES LYON, A RADISSON COLLECTION HOTEL A LEGACY OF TIMELESS CHARM

Cour des Loges Lyon, A Radisson Collection Hotel is found on the pedestrianized Vieux-Lyon, set within an ensemble of 4 historic buildings built for



merchants, bankers, or printers during the Renaissance. France's first Radisson Collection Hotel is the ideal base from which to discover the world-renowned gastronomic delights and many UNESCO World Heritage sites of Lyon.

Originally opened as l'Hôtel Cour des Loges in 1987. Renovated and re-designed again in 2002. Rebranded to Cour des Loges, a member of Radisson Individuals in 2019. Renovated and re-opening as Cour des Loges Lyon, A Radisson Collection Hotel.

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HERITAGE, ART & DESIGN

The four buildings that make up the hotel were originally built as houses for the merchants, bankers and printers who were numerous during the Renaissance period of 15th and 16th century France. Lyon was a wealthy city benefiting from quarterly tax-exempt trade fairs and long stays by the King of France and the Royal Court.

The hotel's four buildings have walls dating back as far back as 1341 combined with 16th, 17th, and 18th century additions. One was built for a spice merchant in the 14th century. Three of the buildings were taken over by Claude de Beaumont, Lord of Burgundy at the 17th century before being handed over to the Jesuits a few years later and used for a college.

Galleries overlooking the courtyard and a majestic Horseshoe staircase, in the seventeenth century style, were added at that time. During the French Revolution of the 17th century, the Church lost possession of the properties and they became a rental housing complex. Miracle-worker Phillipe de Lyon, private doctor to the Tsars is known to have been a tenant.

In the first half of the 20th century, Lyon was less prosperous and suffered degradation before the city protected the historical old town in the 1970s. In 1981 the four buildings underwent a five-year restoration and conversion leading up to the inauguration of l'Hôtel Cour des Loges in February 1987. The hotel was renovated again in 2002 and now is once again being meticulously updated for an unveiling as Cour des Loges Lyon, A Radisson Collection Hotel.

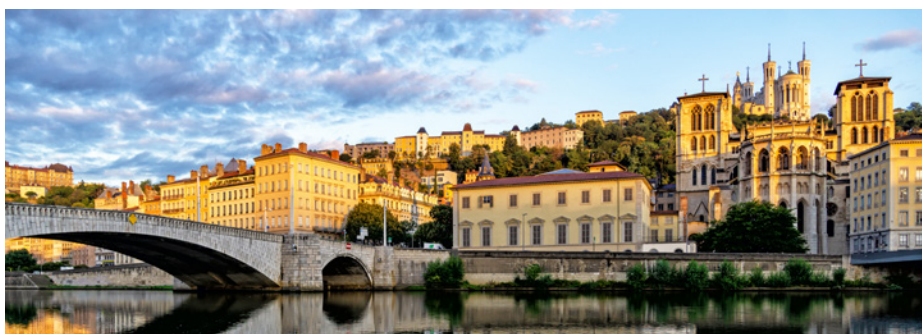
Le Comptoir
